
A silver lining always exists in a dark cloud. We don't have to worry and despair and we have to move on with new ideas and new emerging technologies to make our nation strong and a world leader.

DIRECTOR'S SPACE






THE ORIENTATION PROGRAM



CAREER COUNSELLING SESSIONS AND MOTIVATIONAL LECTURES



Cybersecurity is not only a question of developing defensive technologies but offensive technologies, as well.










FROM EDITOR'S PEN
