Objective of event: 6 points understanding of climate change & its correction and limit the use of energy to slow the pace of global warming.

Summary of Event (Approx. 100 words)

Ambalika Institute of Management & Technology and Institution's Innovation Council had organized a seminar on Solar Energy on 12 June 2023. The speaker was Dr Chetan Singh Solanki from IIT Mumbai who is popularly known as Solar Man of India.

Mr. Ambika Mishra (Executive Director), Prof.(Dr.) Ashutosh Dwivedi (Director) and Dr. Shweta Mishra(Addl Director) of the College welcomed Dr. Solanki by presenting a bouquet. Dr. Chetan Singh Solanki, a professor from IIT Bombay, brand ambassador of Solar Energy for Govt. of MP, and Founder of the Energy Swaraj Foundation is a well known Environment activist who has pledged not to go home until 2030 and to live & travel in the solar bus. During his speech Dr Solanki emphasised on 6 points understanding of climate change & its correction and also he gave rule of AMG (Avoid, Minimise, and Generate) to limit the use of

energy. Gandhiji's statement that "Earth has enough for everybody's need but not for anybody's

greed" is as fundamental as the fact Sun rising from the East. Climate change is threatening not only sustainable life but the sustainability of life on the planet. We have only 6 years left before we reach global warming of 1.50C (IPCC report). Therefore "drastic" and "immediate" actions are required to mitigate climate change. The solution lies in adopting Energy Swaraj or generating and consuming energy locally. Adopting Energy Swaraj will also help in skill development, livelihood creation, energy independence, local economy strengthening, and of course, climate change mitigation.
