Goals:

Assessment Procedures and Outcomes

1. Task assigned to students- *Why I should be hired?*
2. Assessment: Students are to be assessed on Five parameters by *Two internal experts and peer students* using the Likert scale (1: Below Average; 2: Average, 3: Good, 4: Very Good, 5: Excellent).
3. Parameters are:
 - a) **Content:** How strongly a student present his arguments for the job position in his/her choice of business sector with facts?
 - b) **Confidence:** How much does a student believe that he/she can be hired?
 - c) **Clarity:** How does a student present his argument?
 - d) **Fluency:** Is he/ she fluent in speaking?
 - e) **Body language:** How his/her gestures and postures are?
4. Outcomes:
 - a) Students are to be informed and discussed on where they need immediate improvement on the specified parameters.
 - b) The threshold Value is 3 (If the score is below 3, a student needs immediate improvement on the parameter).

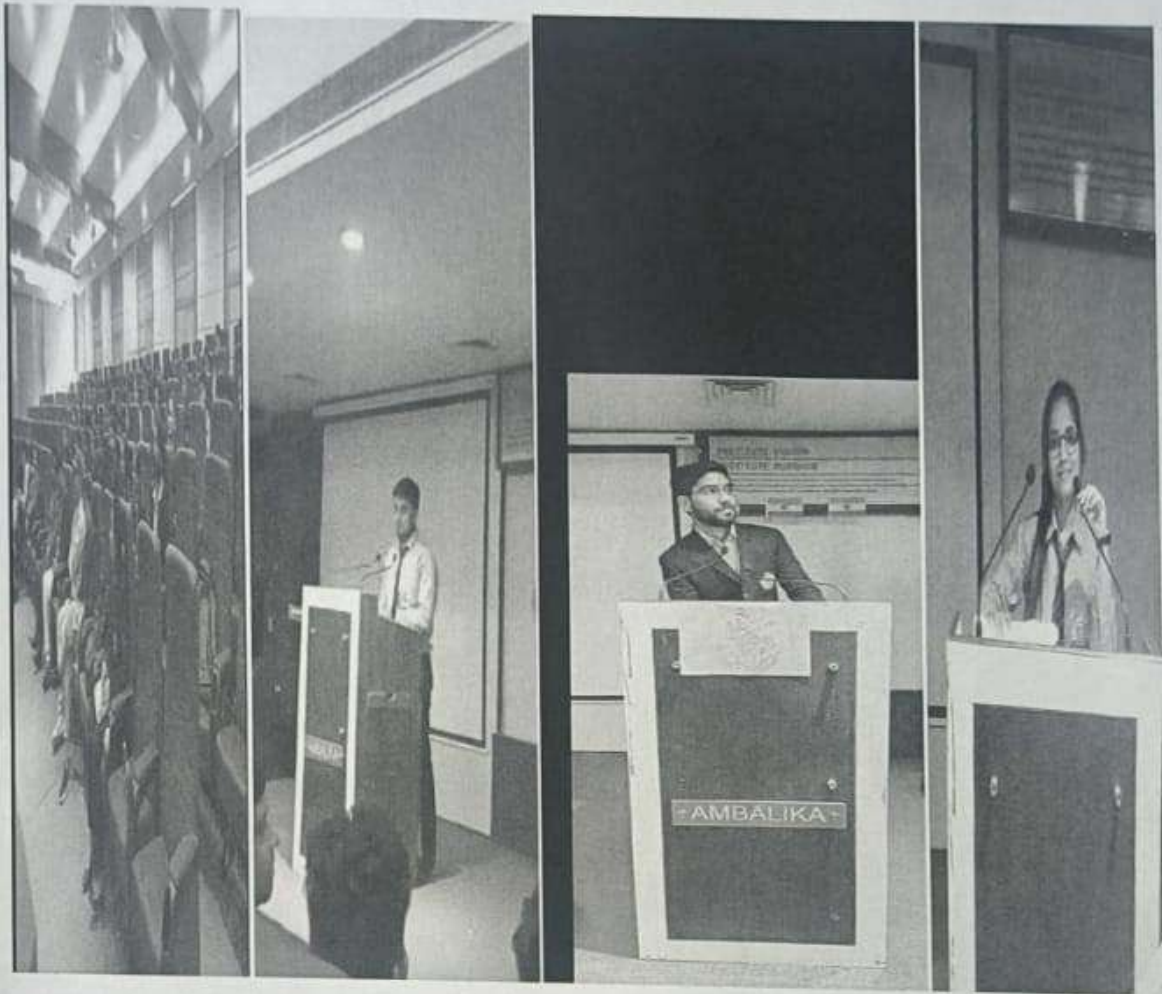
