OBJECTIVES OF THE FINANCIAL DETECTIVE – A FINANCIAL STATEMENT ANALYSIS AND INTERPRETATION COMPETITION

The main objectives of the competition are:

- To understand the student's essential components of financial statements, such as balance sheets, income statements, and cash flow statements.
- To understand the students how financial statements are prepared and how to analyze them to make informed decisions.
- To simulate real-world scenarios and challenges students may face when analyzing financial statements.
- To promote teamwork and collaboration among students, as they work together to analyze financial statements and make decisions.
- To develop the students critical thinking and analytical skills

RULES & FORMAT REGARDING FINANCIAL DETECTIVE COMPETITION

There are certain rules are given below regarding Financial Detective Competitions which are followed by each team in the competition.

- 1. There will be only **FIVE** participants on each team.
- 2. Only TWO teams can participate at a time
- 3. Teams will be provided with a set of Financial Statements from a company i.e.(Income Statement, Balance Sheet and Cash Flow Statement)
- 4. Each team has TWO days to prepare and analyze the statements.
- 5. The report must include a detailed analysis of the financial statements of the selected company.
- 6. The report should cover the following aspects: Overview of the Company's Financial Performance, Analysis of the Company's Liquidity, Solvency, and Profitability, Ration Analysis of the Company Financial Statements, Interpretation of the Financial Analysis, and Recommendations for Improvement.
- 7. The submission should include a written report on no more than 10 pages
- 8. Teams will have to prepare their REPORT of maximum 15 Slides (PPT)
- 9. Teams can not mention their names in anywhere except attendance sheet.
- 10. The competition judges will evaluate the reports based on the Accuracy, Completeness, Clarity and Effectiveness.
